

 The University of Pennsylvania Architectural Conservation Laboratory requests \$3,000 to begin the inventory and survey of the heavy brick and tile making machinery throughout the site of the Western Clay Manufacturing Co. In conjunction with the Montana Preservation Alliance and the Archie Bray Foundation the work on the site will provide a roadmap for the future stabilization and restoration of these significant artifacts.

In 2011-12, MPA enlisted Professor Frank Matero and the University of Pennsylvania Architectural Conservation Laboratory to structurally assess and create a plan to conserve the Western Clay Manufacturing Co. historic industrial site of the Archie Bray Foundation (ABF). Now in the second year of work, a thorough understanding of both the evolution of the site and the current condition and integrity of its buildings and machinery will help the partners to strategize a creative future for this remarkable and now rare survival of American industrial heritage.
