On behalf of the "Unreal Project" research team, we would like to submit an application to request a grant of \$3,000 from the Society for Industrial Archeology Industrial Heritage Preservation Grants. We are requesting funding to support the construction of digital models of a quintessential factory town: Sugar Land, Texas, the former headquarters of the Imperial Sugar Company, the state's oldest extant business, and to explore the industrial heritage environment in immersive visualization or virtual reality. The project proposes to conduct archeological, archaeological and urban historical research through virtual heritage visualization of a multifaceted history town: Sugar Land, the former headquarters of the Imperial Sugar Company, the first sugar refinery in Texas and the state's oldest. This town, and the industrial heart of the town is on the cusp of a large redevelopment project. If the redevelopment project fails to reflect the rich history of the town and the sugar industry, much of the history and identity of the town and its people will be lost. In order to preserve the town and its present history and culture, this project aims to construct digital models of the factory town and explore the industrial heritage environment in virtual visualization. It will also aim to construct digital models of the town and its people in order to provide a virtual experience of the town and its people that are otherwise difficult or impossible to access. The results of this project will serve as both archeological documentation and as an aid to the community of Sugar Land to help in the identification, preservation and interpretation of the city's industrial past.
